Greeting

{ I'm writing to appeal for a third attempt to complete KIN 375 – Physiology of Sport / Physical Activity. }

Why the appeal is being submitted, one sentence

I failed KIN 375 the first time I took it, during the Spring 2017 semester. I attribute this failure to my lack of proper focus and unwillingness to approach Dr. Goldfarb for assistance.

I enrolled in KIN 375 this past summer, with Dr. Davis. Realizing this would be my last opportunity, I gave my best effort to succeed. I was performing very well in the course, when midway through the third week I received word from home that my father had been fatally injured in a car accident. I went home for six days. Upon my return, I worked hard to catch up with the material, to include meeting with Dr. Davis for assistance on several occasions. Although I achieved some success, I was also distracted by my family situation. In the end, in earning a C- grade I fell short of the minimum C grade required for successful fulfillment of the Department of Kinesiology standard.

While I don't want to make excuses for not achieving the standard the second time I took the course, I hope the committee will understand the extenuating circumstances in my situation. As evidence to substantiate my appeal, I have attached my father's obituary that was published in our hometown newspaper, as well as a short letter of support from Dr. Davis on my behalf.
