STEP 2: INITIAL ADVISEMENT AND COURSEWORK

A MSAT Degree in Athletic Training from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro requires a minimum of 50 credit hours beyond the bachelor's degree; including 6 hours of core requirements, 3 hours of research techniques, 29 hours of athletic training required courses, and 12 hours of integrative clinical experience. No course below the 500 level will be counted towards graduate degree requirements. In all programs, at least 50% of the work credited toward the degree must be 600-level courses or higher. The program of study may include no more than 6 hours of independent study. A minimum of 24 hours must be completed in the Department of KIN. Refer to the Graduate School Bulletin for more detail on program requirements.

Transfer Credits: Ordinarily, credits transferred from graduate work taken at other institutions may not exceed one-third of the minimum (12 credit hours) required by the Program of Study. Specific course transfers are subject to approval by the recommendations of the student's advisory committee. The student must have earned a grade of B (3.0) or better in any course they wish to transfer.
